Course Descriptions

Required Courses (10 Credits each)

(BI800) Bible Overview

Rev. Tom Thorpe

Build your Bible knowledge with this overview of biblical history and metaphysics. Make sure you take this basic course as early in your studies as possible.

(BI605) Interpretation of the Hebrew Scriptures

Rev. Paul Hasselbeck

The tools of metaphysical interpretation will be used to explore various stories from the Old Testament.

(IS800) Development of the Unity Movement

Rev. Tom Thorpe

Examine the development of the Unity movement as an institution and an idea. Review the spiritual evolution of Charles and Myrtle Fillmore along with their unique contributions and the spiritual principles underlying the expansion of Unity's work.

(PR801) Meditation Practices (Life of Prayer)

Rev. Paul Hasselbeck

This class explores several different meditation practices. You will have an opportunity to experience these practices and discover ones that work best for you.

Elective Courses (10 credits each)

Conscious Evolution & Spiritual Transformation, Rev. Toni Fish

This course is a study of perspectives on the evolution of individual and societal consciousness and its relationship to spiritual transformation. We will look at the fundamental truths that surface in the different perspectives/systems and work to relate them to our own experiences of transformation.
